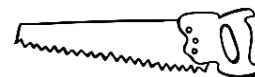

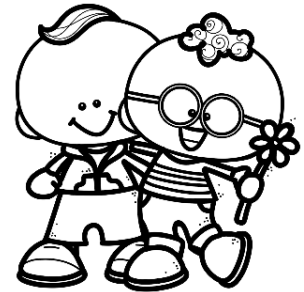

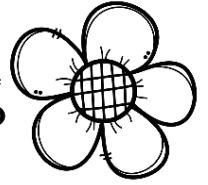

eight: a number

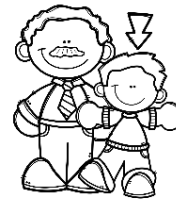
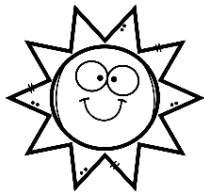
